

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. This is a DRAFT schedule. There may be changes made between now and registration, although we will attempt to keep them to a minimum.
2. Students will be given the opportunity to **preregister for clinics** between Monday, October 6, 8:30 a.m. and Thursday, October 9, 5:00 p.m. All clinics have additional hour requirements beyond the class times, and some have specific time periods in which the work must be done. Make sure to check the requirements of each clinic before selecting a clinic to make sure that the requirements do not conflict with a class you plan to enroll in. More information will be circulated closer to the preregistration for clinics.
3. After preregistration for clinics occurs, 3Ls will be able to preregister for Law Firm Program (LFP) courses. More information will be circulated closer to the preregistration for LFPs.
4. Priority for clinics and LFPs is given to those graduating in May and July 2026.
5. After preregistration for LFPs occurs, graduating 3Ls will be able to preregister for the Bar Exam Strategies (BES) course. More information will be circulated closer to the preregistration for BES.
6. There will be the following academic advising sessions to discuss the sign-up process for classes:

Clinical Advising Session: Tuesday, September 30, 1:00 – 2:00 p.m.

Dual JD Advising Session: Friday, October 3, 1:00 – 2:00 p.m.

JD Advising Session: Monday, October 6, 1:00 – 2:00 p.m.

All sessions will be on Zoom and recorded. After attending these sessions or watching the recordings, if students still have questions, they may make appointments with Deans Archerd (Academic Affairs), Jennings (Student Affairs), or Khan (Registrar). Dean Archerd generally advises on which courses might be a good fit for students' academic goals and progress toward graduation. Dean Jennings can also recommend courses and helps arrange changes in status, such as full-time to part-time student status. Dean Khan advises on registration procedures and graduation requirements.

7. Registration for other courses will be held in November. Dean Khan will be emailing the specific dates for registration, which depend on the credit hours earned by students.
8. Please read the General Guidelines for Course Selection for the JD and Dual JD Programs that accompany this schedule as well as the list of courses that describe the types of courses.
9. Please pay attention to prerequisites when registering. For example, Trial Practice requires students to have either taken Evidence or be taking it in the same term as the Trial Practice Course. The Criminal Trial Clinic requires Evidence as a prerequisite.
