

DIRECTED RESEARCH: TRANSNATIONAL

- Form deadline: must be submitted to the Law Registrar by the end of the second week of class

Directed Research: Transnational projects are original research papers that address a distinct legal topic or problem and contain a meaningful Canadian law component. The projects are completed by Dual JD program students with the supervision of a resident Detroit Mercy Law faculty member (or, where permitted, adjunct faculty), where the project is within the faculty member's area of expertise.

A Directed Research: Transnational project **does not** fulfill the upper-level writing requirement, however, it **does** satisfy a student's Dual JD Transnational Law Requirement, provided that the project includes a meaningful Canadian law component.

A student must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or better to enroll in Directed Research: Transnational.
